Tuesday, 15th June: Triangular races in Sonderborg Bay

Wednesday, 16th June: Long-distance Sonderborg-Kappeln

Thursday, 17th June: Triangular races on the Schlei

Saturday, 19th June: Rendezvous of the Classics race in Kiel-Long-distance

Long-distance: various courses depending on boat size.

Triangular races: two races are planned for each.

At least 5 competitors required per class,
otherwise boats will be entered into “open class”.

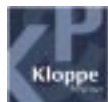

RULES:

The Robbe & Berking Classic Week 2010 will take place according to the race rules of the ISAF, the organisation regulations of the DSV, announcements and sailing instructions. Announcements and sailing instructions will be distributed to all skippers.

Boats will be assigned to a race class depending on their type and KLR value, in the dinghy and Jollenkreuzer classes depending on type and KLR values calculated from the yardstick system.
